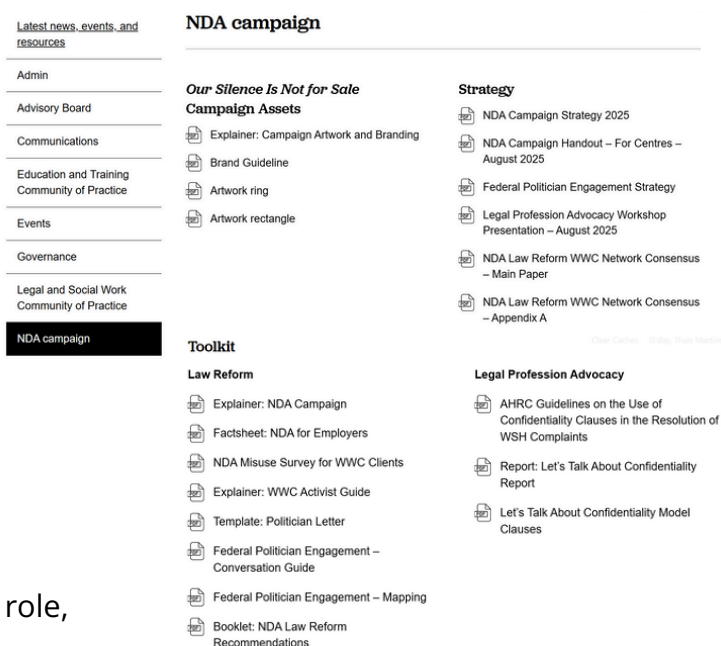


On the left-hand side, you will see a navigation menu with dedicated tabs. These tabs help you quickly access content relevant to your role and areas of work.

03 Exploring the NDA campaign tab

One of the tabs in the menu is the NDA Campaign section, which houses materials for the Our Silence Is Not for Sale campaign. This area includes:

- Campaign strategy and assets, including artwork and brand guideline
- Toolkits and key resources, such as:
- NDA campaign explainer and factsheets
- Letter templates for politicians
- Conversation guides
- Templates for people who may wish to become campaign activists
- Legal Profession Advocacy resources

04 Using the Events and News Areas as a Collaborative Space

The Events and News areas are shared spaces designed to support collaboration, visibility, and learning across the network.

Use the Events area to stay informed about:

- Nationally planned activities and key milestones
- Events hosted by Centres that are relevant across the network
- Internal meetings involving more than one Centre

If you would like your event to appear on the Hub, [please refer to the one-page guide on how to create an event in the Hub](#). This ensures consistency and improves visibility across all Centres.

Use the News area to share updates that may be relevant or useful to the wider network, including:

- Key updates from your Centre
- Examples of good practice, innovative approaches, or effective strategies
- Campaign milestones, advocacy wins, or learnings that could be replicated elsewhere
- Reflections or insights that support national alignment and shared learning

If you have an update, story, or example that may benefit other Centres, [please follow the one-page guide for publishing News on the Hub](#). Using the guide helps ensure content is accessible, well-structured, and aligned with network standards.
